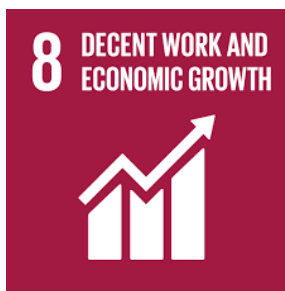

Current Situation

- ▶ SDG indicator Baseline Report for Myanmar has been launched in 2017 (joint effort of CSO and UNDP)
- ▶ Conducted labour force survey since 1990
- ▶ Used projection data for many years
- ▶ Surveys on LF, School to work transition, Child labour in 2015
- ▶ Annual Quarterly LFS started from 2017 (twice per year)
- ▶ 14 SDGs indicators related to labour
- ▶ Currently 10 indicators is provided to CSO (SDGs monitoring authority)

Way Forward

Priority

- ▶ 2019 LFS will collect some OSH information and data(8.8.1)
- ▶ Also family remittance of overseas migrants workers(consulting IMF and the Central Bank of Myanmar)
