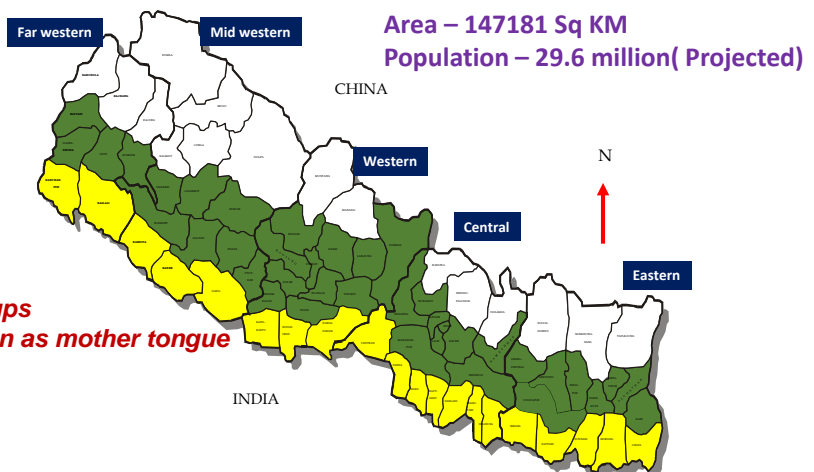

Nepal- a small but diverse country

- 7 provinces
- 5 development regions
- 3 ecological region
 - Mountain
 - Hill
 - Terai

10 religions
125 caste/ethnic groups
123 languages spoken as mother tongue



Working approach to SDG reporting in Nepal

- SDGs has been mainstreamed into national plan, program and budgeting systems
- SDGs coding system applied to each and every program of current Fiscal Year
- Government has formed three levels of committees:
 - SDG High-level Steering Committee chaired by Prime Minister
 - SDG Coordination Committee chaired by NPC Vice Chairperson
 - SDG Implementation & Monitoring Thematic Committees (nine) chaired by NPC members
- Private sectors, development partners are all on board to support SDG implementation
- SDG data and metadata has been disseminated through NPC web portal
- Major Data Sources:
 1. Management Information System
 2. Surveys: DHS, LFS, LSMS, MICS, TUS
 3. Censuses: Population, Agriculture and Economic
- SDG reporting module has been incorporated under NPC web page [<https://www.npc.gov.np>]

Labour Issues and way forward

- Policy Issues
 - ILO resolutions have been adopted for all labour (formal and informal) related rights and benefits
 - 10 year master plan on child labour elimination
 - Eliminate all forms of worst child labour by 2022
 - Eliminate all child labour by 2025
 - Legal provisions including standard have been adopted on occupational safety
 - PM Employment Program being launched
 - Social Protection Schemes being declared
- Major Data Issues
 - Historical Population Censuses on long run (last 12 months); data available since last 60 years
 - Labour Force (Household) Survey on short run (last 7 days); data available since 1997/98
- Labour Force (Household) Survey on short run with Decent Work Criteria, 19th ICLS:
 - Data collection completed in 2018 (includes modules on DW, child labour, forced labour etc)
 - Data processing (editing/tabulations) going on
 - Data dissemination planned at the end of the year 2018
