Challenges for strengthening Statistical System

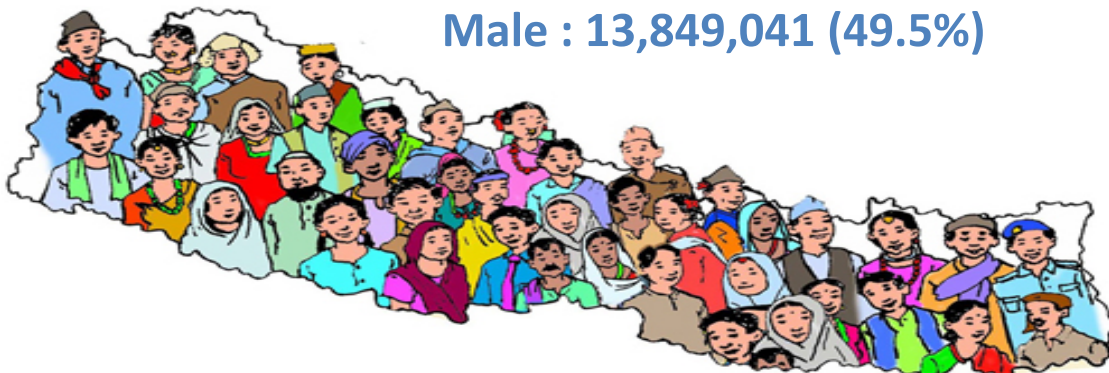
- Less preference by Political leader

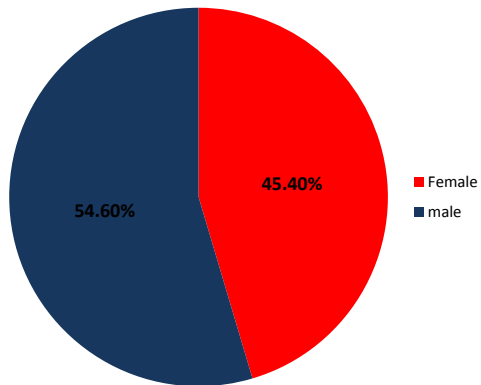

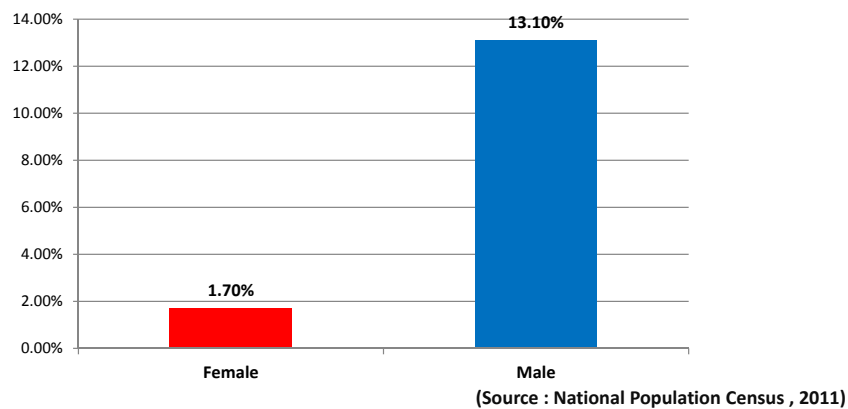
Genderwise Disability

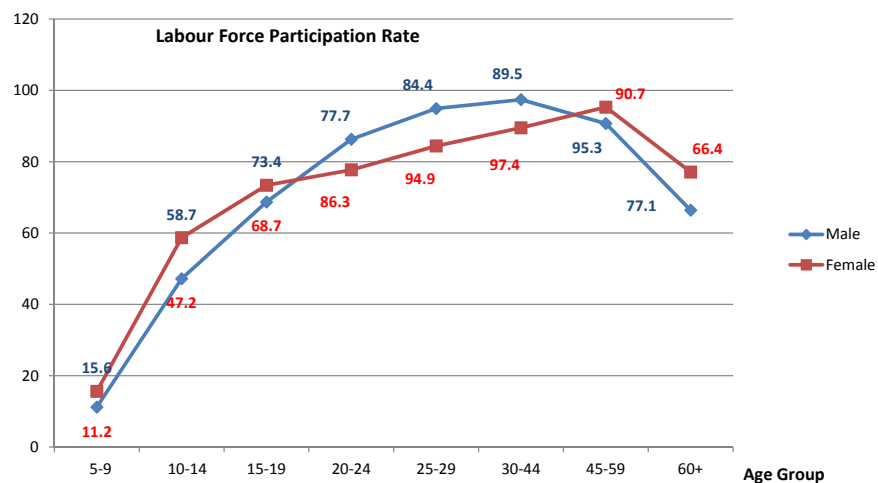
Percentage of Employment to 15+ Population

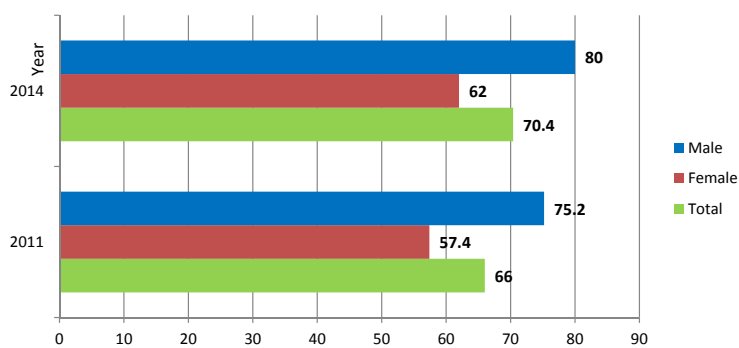


Labour Force Participation Rate

Literacy Rate

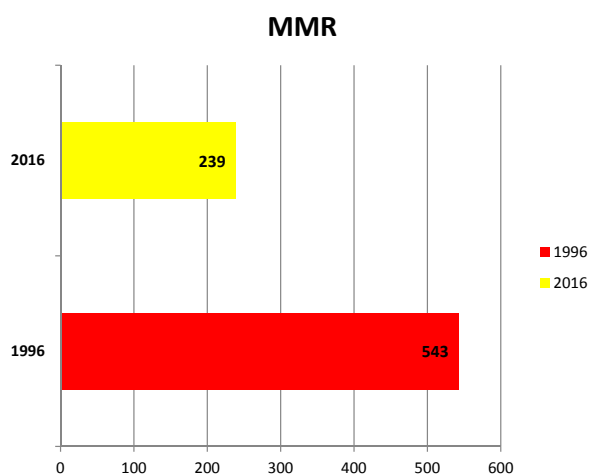

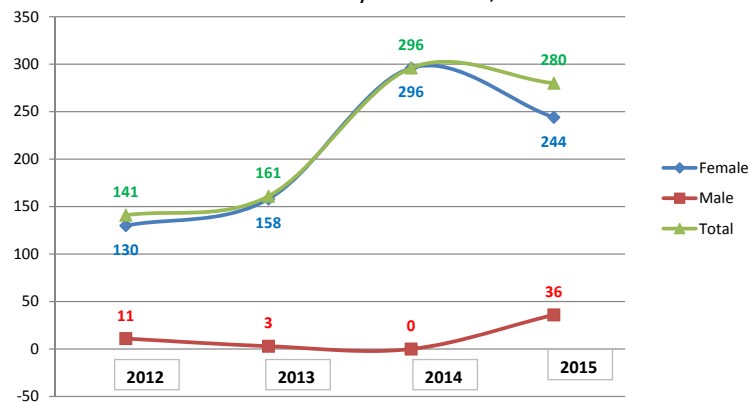

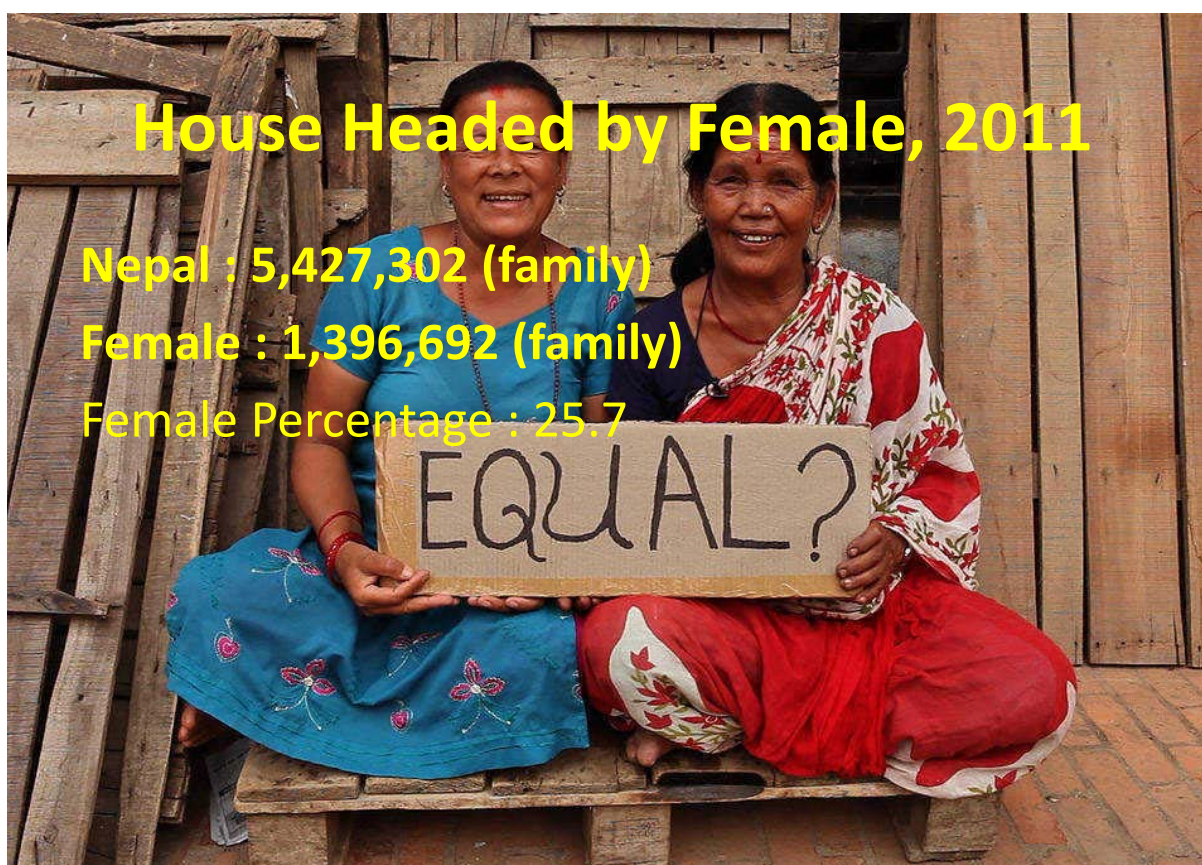
