

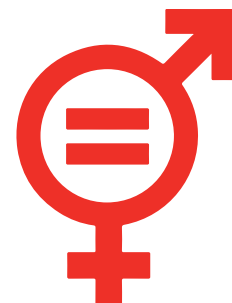

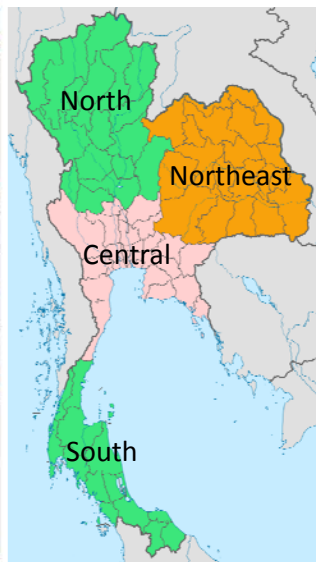

- To promote and support all government agencies to be able to produce statistical data in accordance with standardized quality

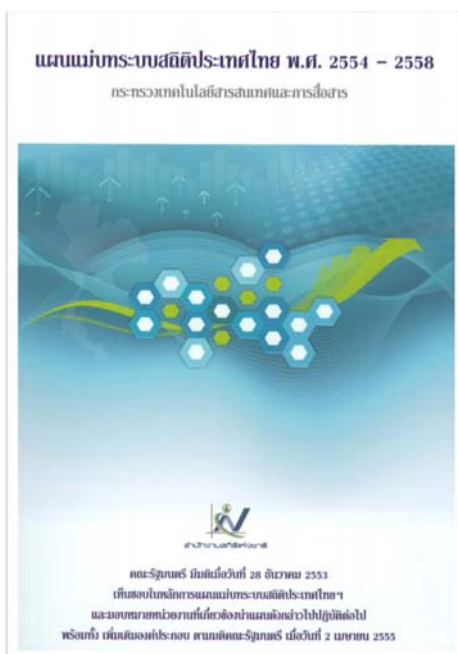
Thailand Statistical Master Plans (TSMP)

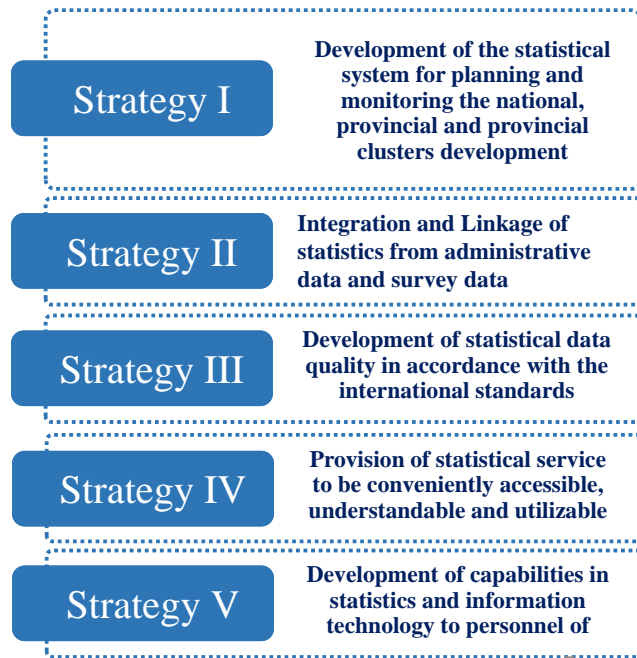

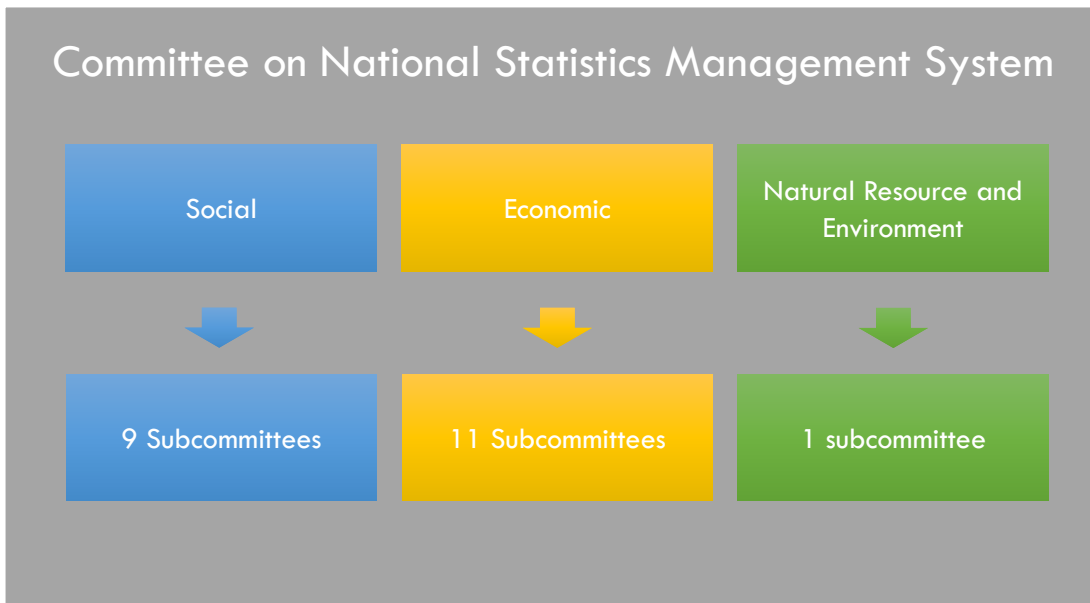

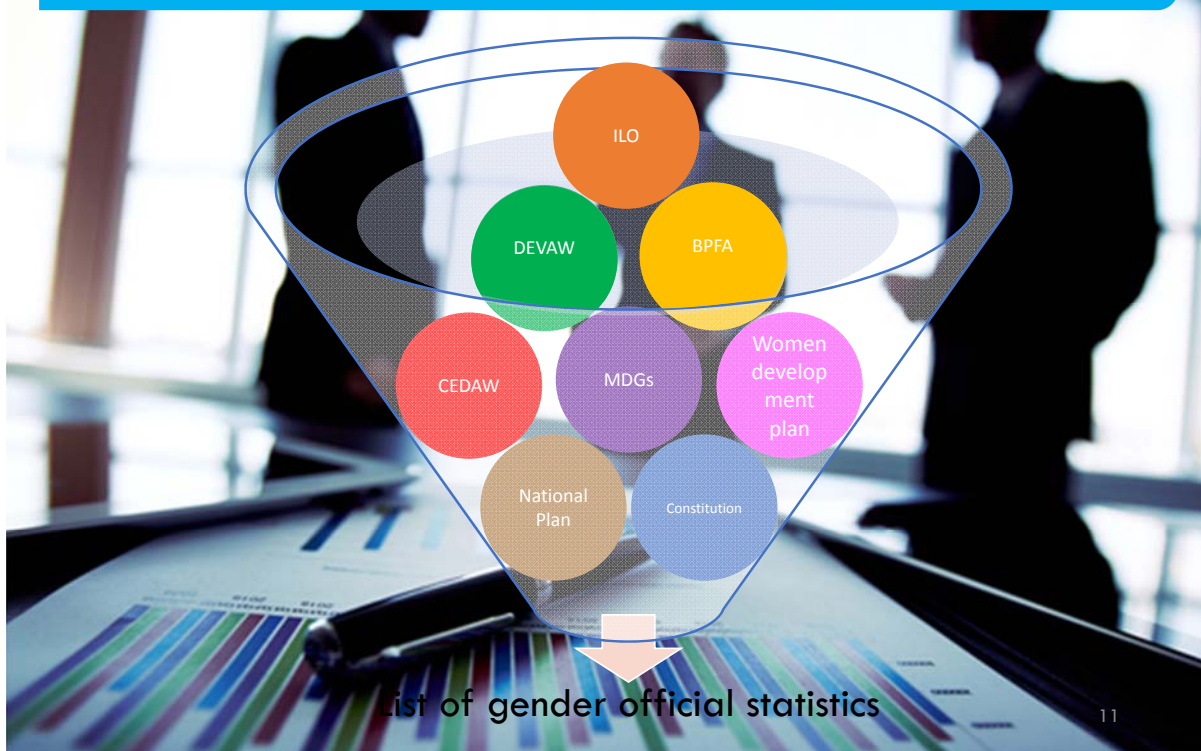
Gender Statistics Subcommittee (GSS)

- Lack of quality of data assessment and insurance
- Insufficient knowledges and experiences in data and statistics
