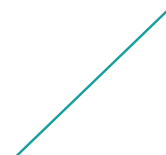

What is NSDS?

- A framework



– allows *statistical* [activities, capacity development, and infrastructure] *improvements* to be *well-planned*

- A process



– enables *coordination* between stakeholders in NSS and technical and financial partners

- A product



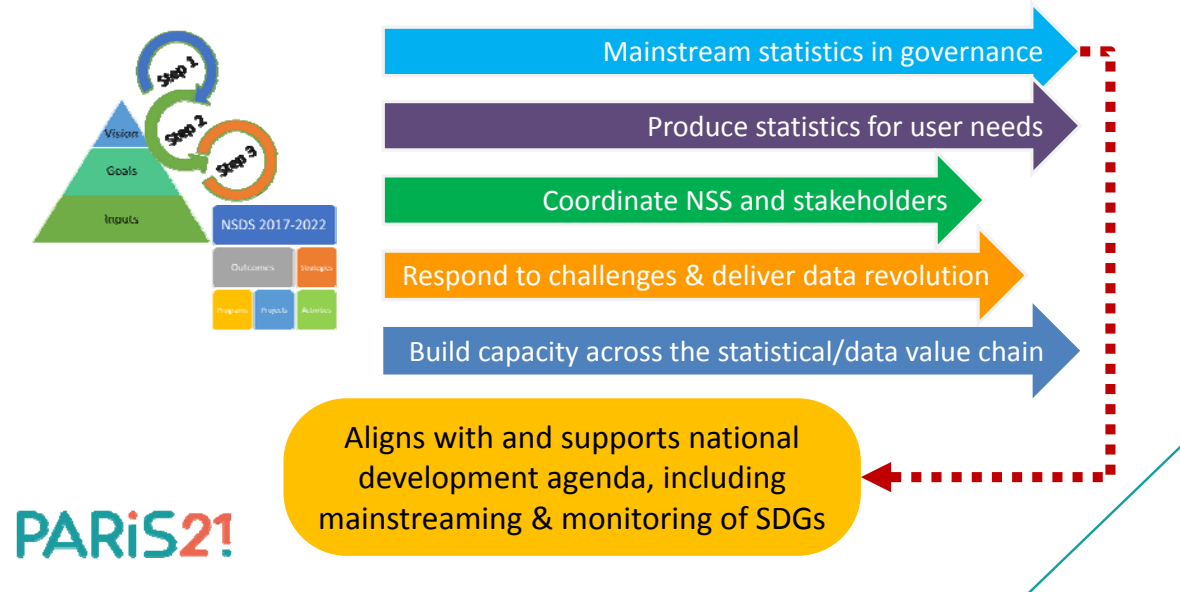
– provides a country with a *vision* and a detailed, *costed action plan* for official statistics for 5-10 years

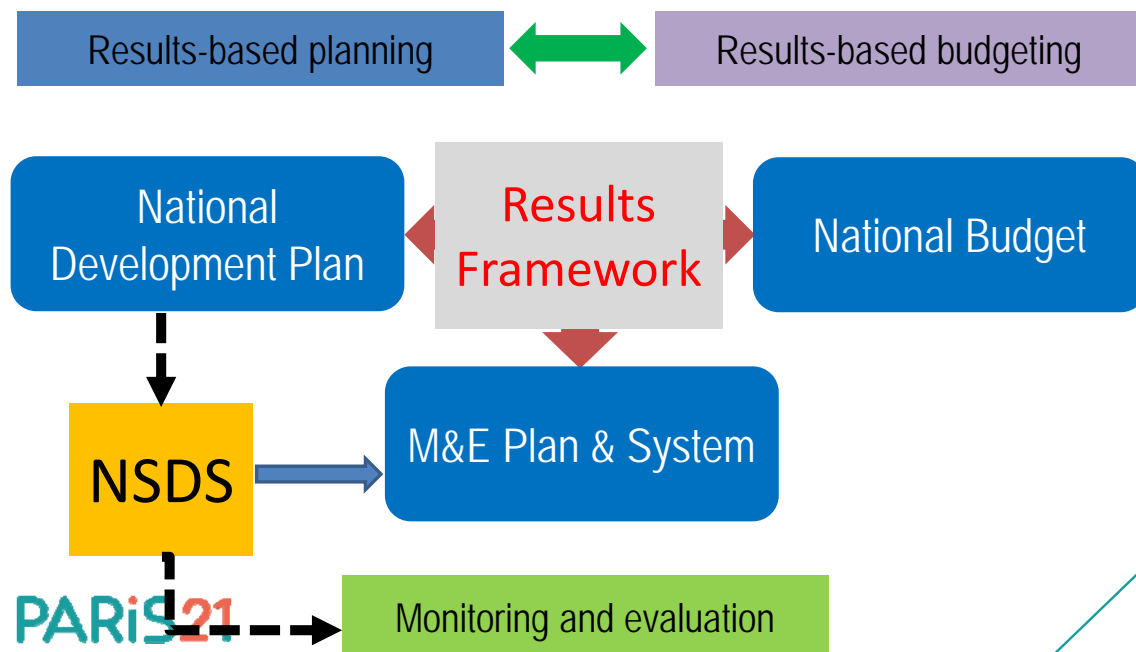

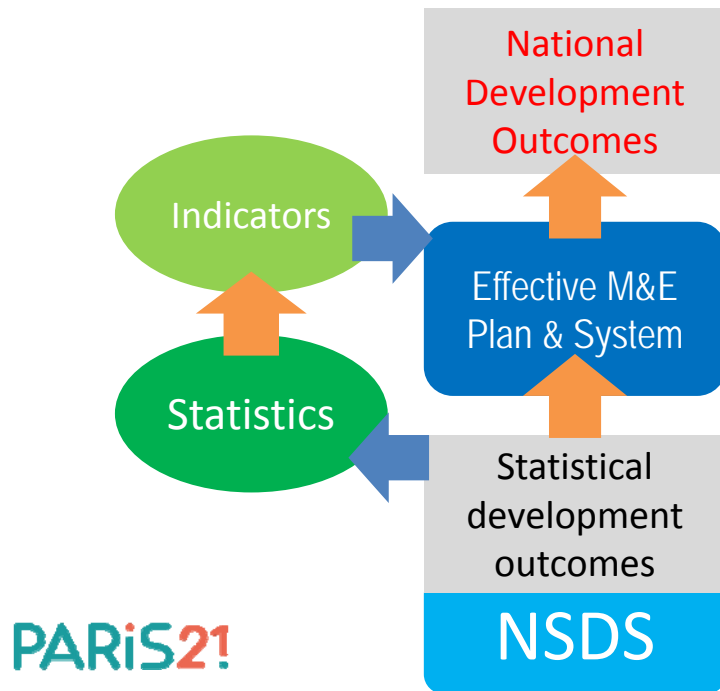

The NSDS Framework

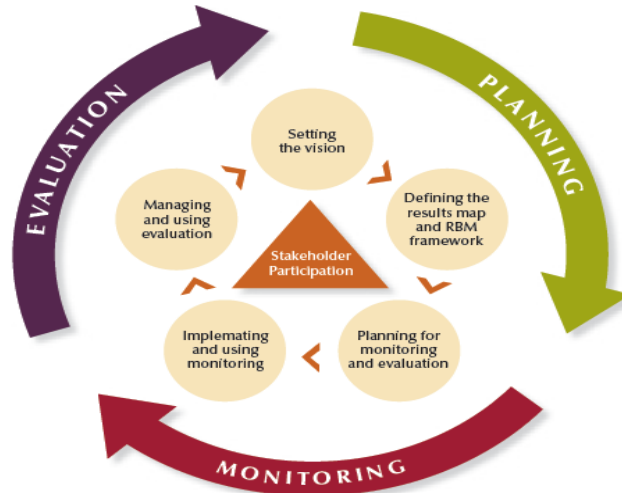
- A results-based management approach
 - a management strategy where all members of an organization (or national statistical system)
 - ensure that their processes, products and services contribute to the delivery of desired results; and
 - use information and evidence on actual results for
 - decisionmaking on the design, resourcing, and implementation of programmes and activities
 - accountability and reporting.



The NSDS Framework

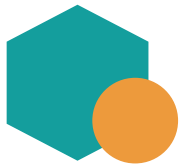
- Follows the results-based management cycle

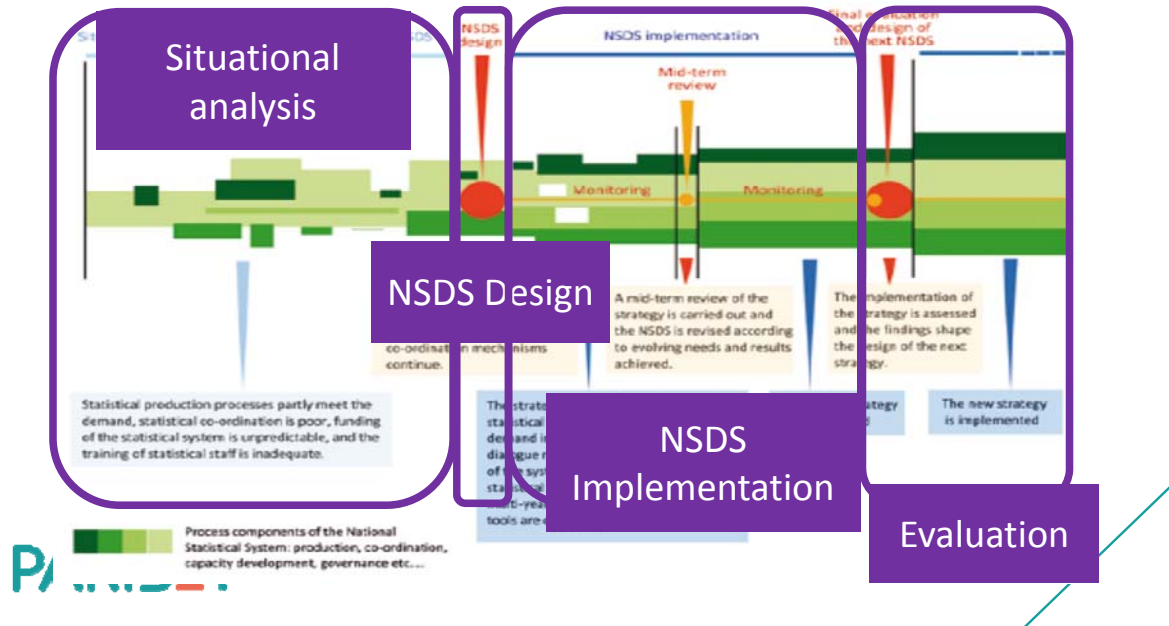

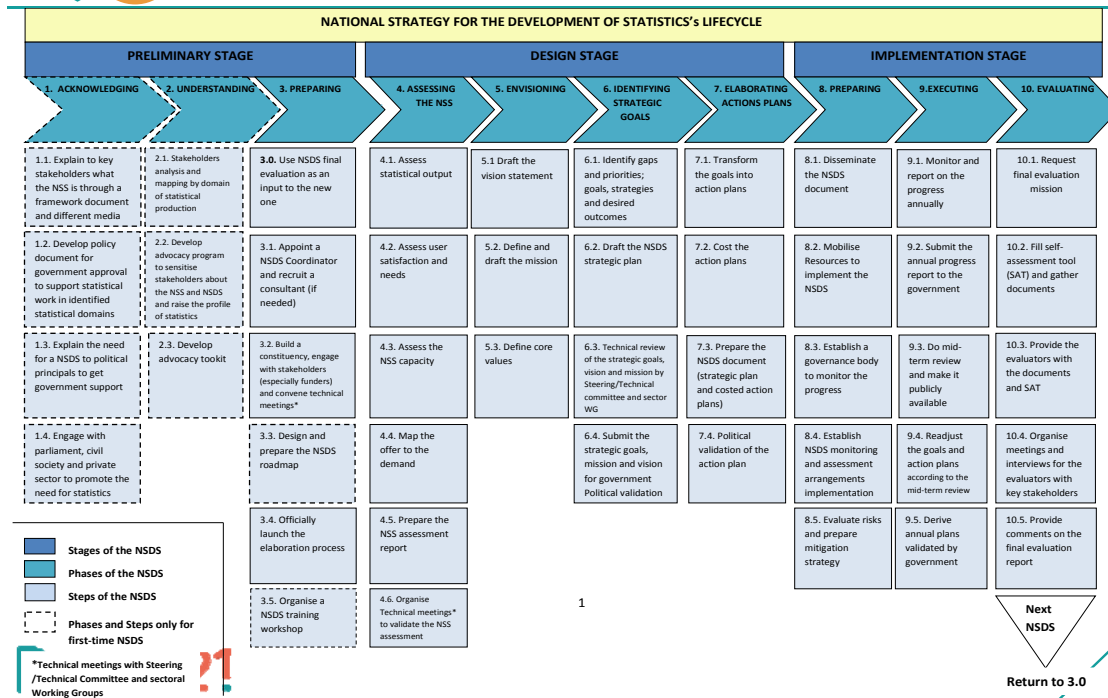

Overview of the NSDS process

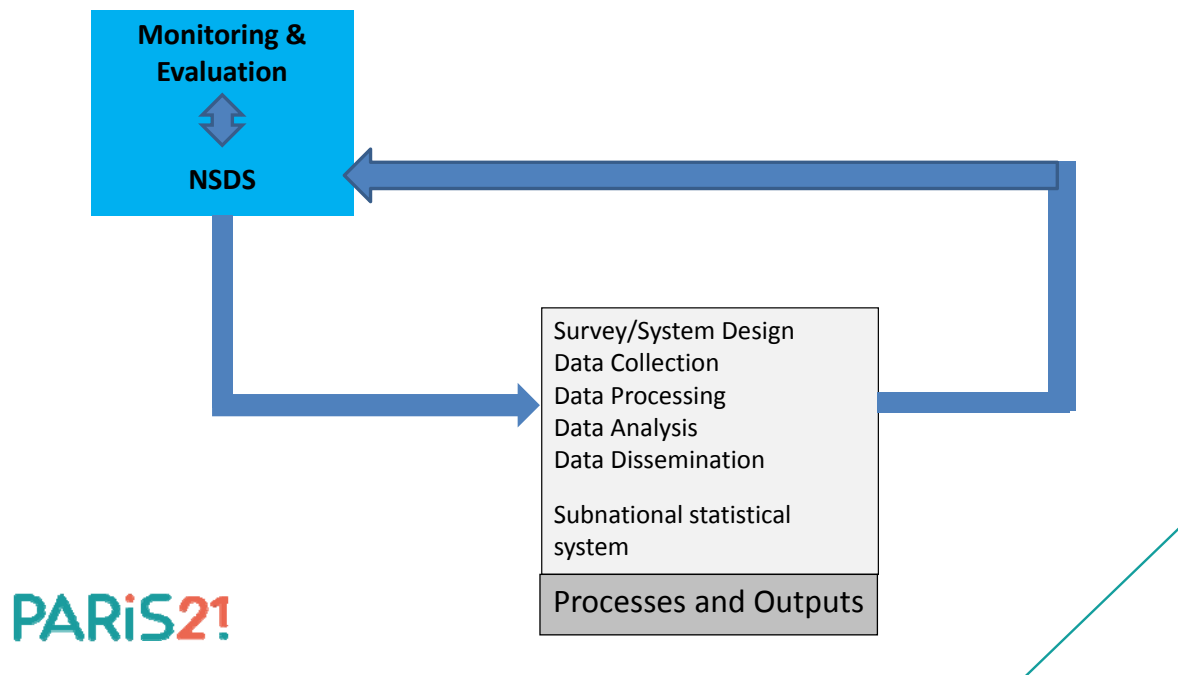

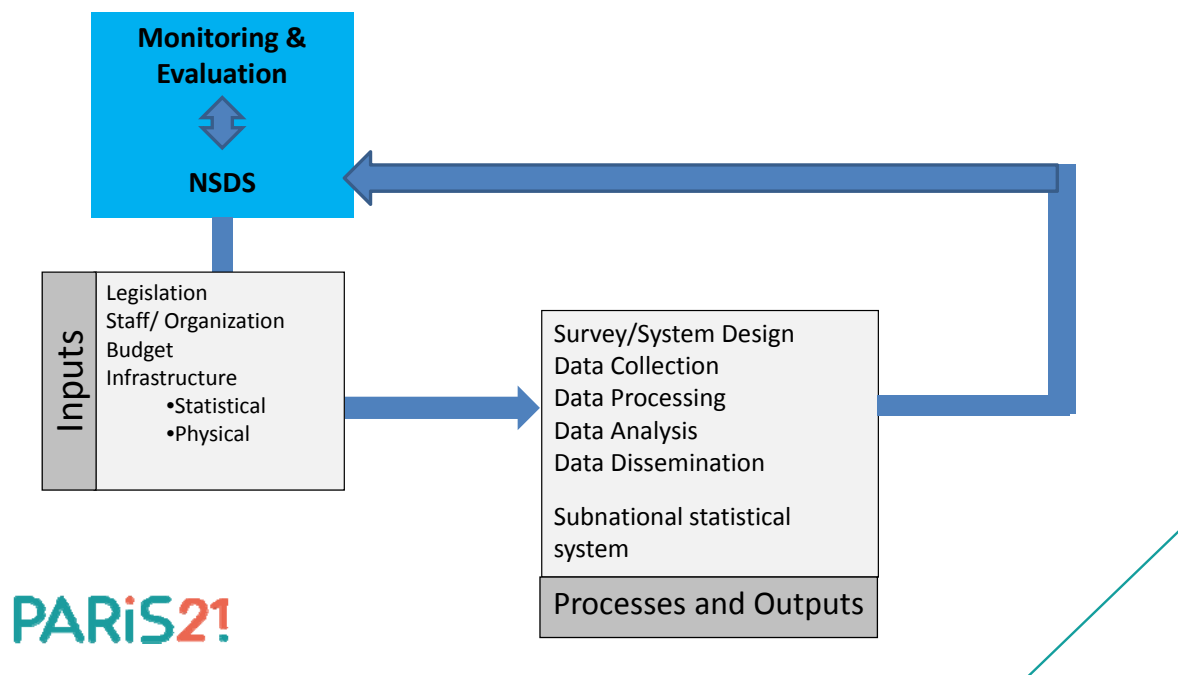

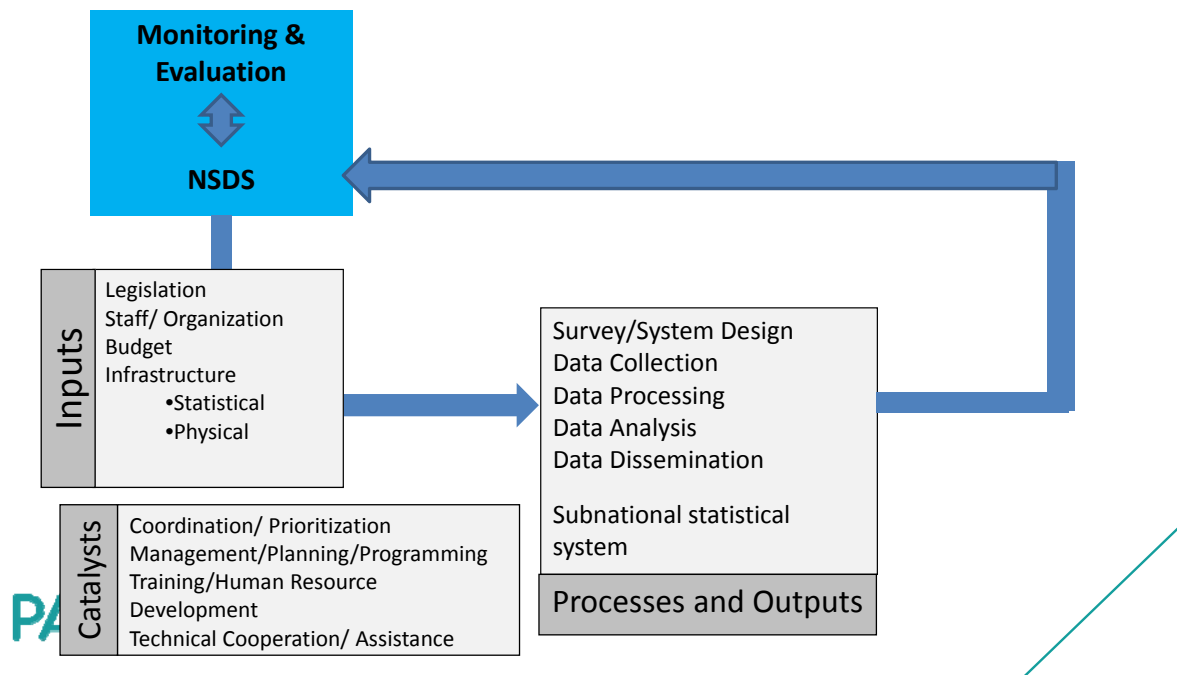


Framework of statistical capacity building and managing development for results

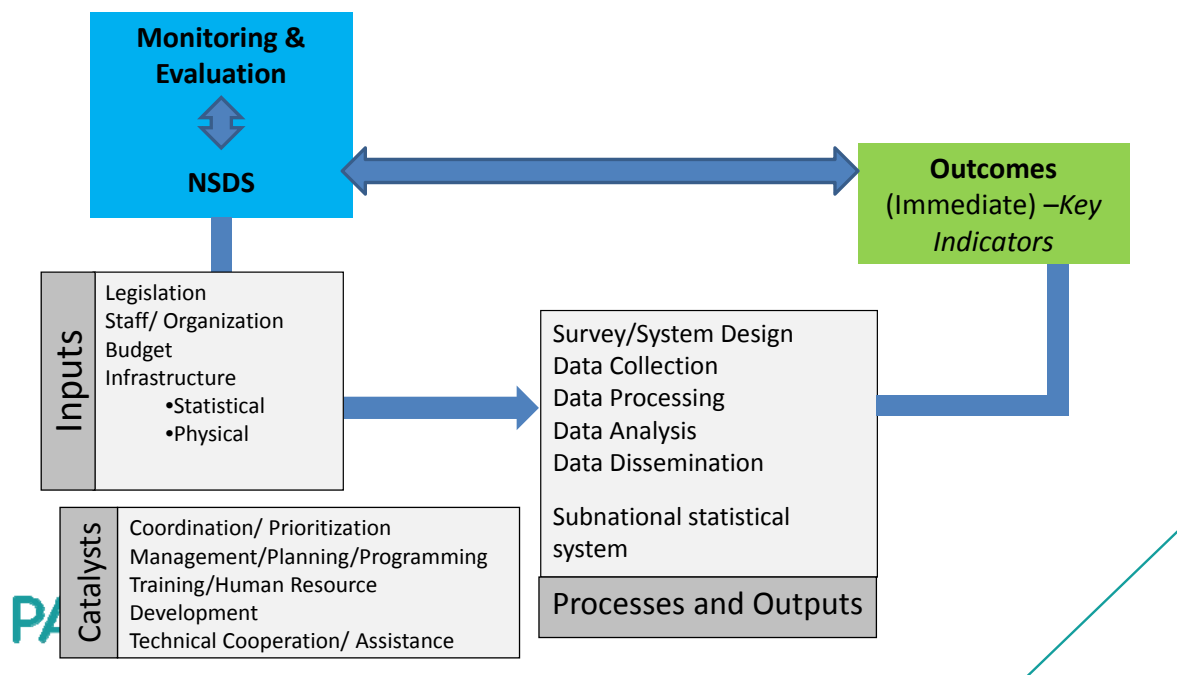

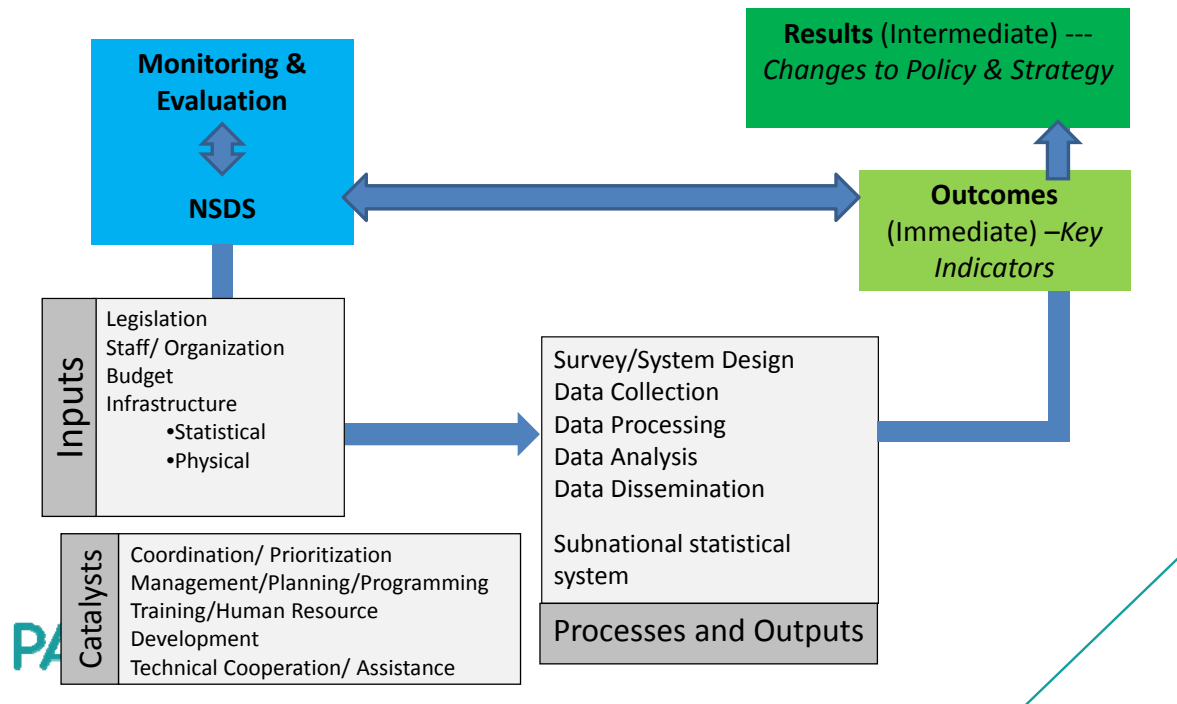

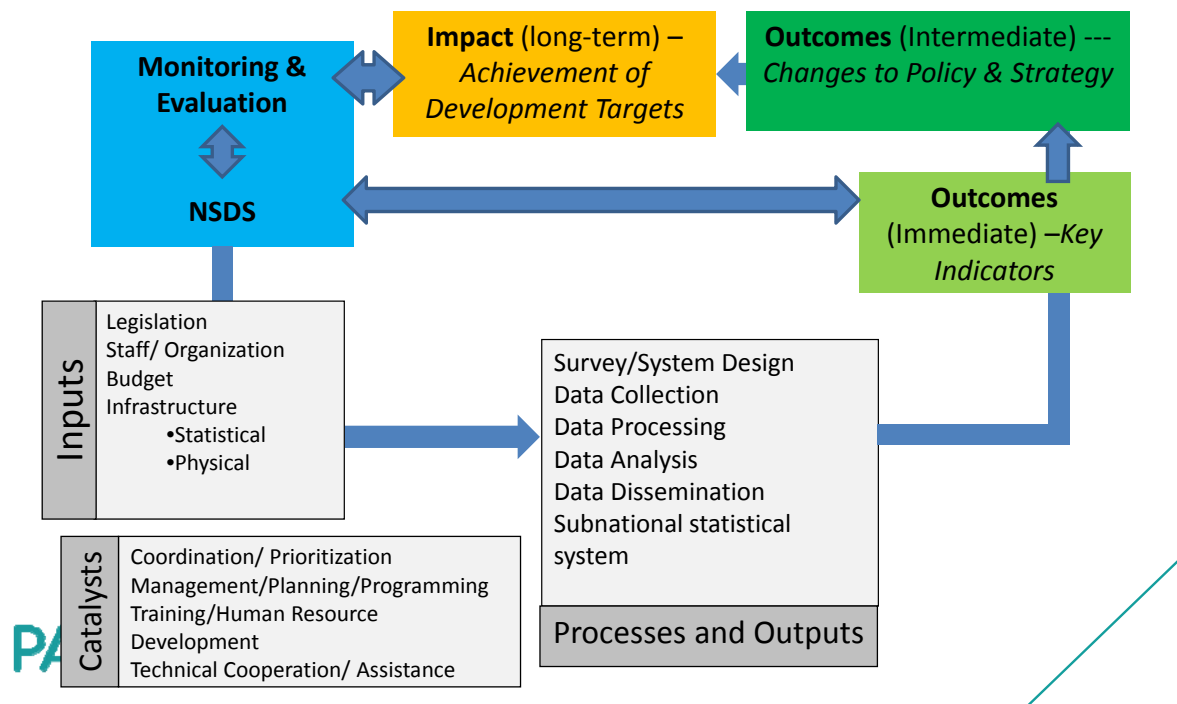

NSDS success factors

- Key success factors in implementing NSDS
 - Strong *political support and explicit recognition* of statistics in national development strategies
 - Keen *dialogue* with key data user groups (government, private sector, civil society) regarding their needs, including the planning and M&E of SDGs
 - *Common strategy* integrating all components of the NSS
 - *Domestic funding* with coordinated support from partners.
