

ASEAN Community Statistical System (ACSS)

- ✓ partnership between national statistical systems of ASEAN Member States, ASEAN Community Councils and ASEAN Secretariat (ASEANstats)
- ✓ a call for united and concerted efforts toward building a system that will <u>facilitate the collection</u>, <u>production</u>, <u>dissemination and communication of ASEAN statistics in</u> <u>support of a rule-based ASEAN Community</u>.





ACSS: Efforts, Challenges and Opportunities

Major Partners of ACSS

- 1. ACSS Committee as the highest regional policy making and coordinating body on ASEAN statistics → with members: Chief Statisticians or Heads of NSOs of all ASEAN Member States (AMSs), and Head of ASEAN Statistics Division (ASEANstats).
- **2. National Statistical Systems** of all AMSs, with NSO as country focal point on ASEAN statistics.
- **3. ASEAN Secretariat** through Statistics Division (<u>ASEANstats</u>) as the regional focal point of ASEAN statistics and the technical arm and member/secretariat of the ACSS Committee.
- 4. ASEAN Community Councils, thru its ASEAN bodies, as the primary stakeholders → provide guidance on data needs and strategic directions for statistical development in ASEAN Community.


