SGGST: Report of activities in 2019

- Subgroup on Gender Statistics training: Tasked with
 - Generating a repository of training experts on this topic
 - Generating a training curriculum on gender statistics
 - Promote the implementation of training on gender statistics across the region
 - Promote the quality of training on gender statistics across the region
- SGGST's work in 2019:
 - Group met three times so far (Jan, July, December)
 - Significant progress achieved on Repository
 - Significant progress on materials for Curriculum
 - Begun work on advocacy
 - Quality work ensured through peer-review process
 - Set up a reporting mechanism

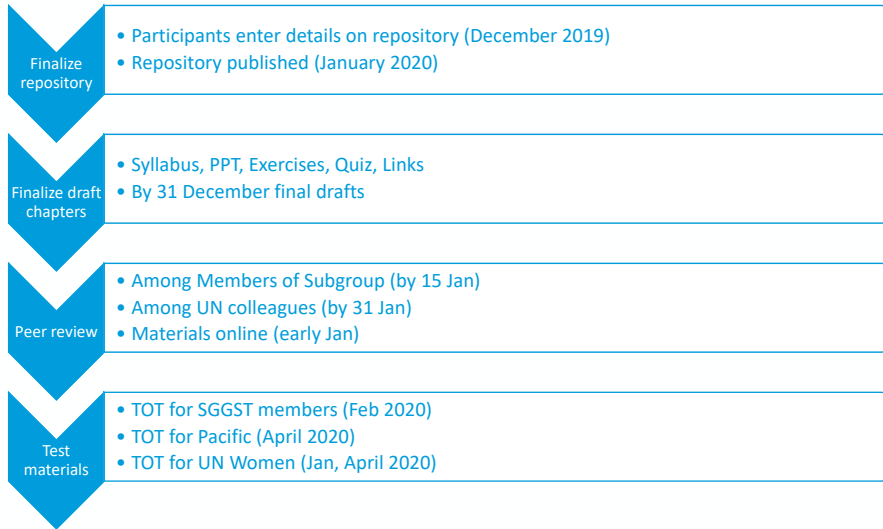

- Enhanced availability of gender data
- Enhanced gender-informed national policies
- Enhanced use of gender statistics for news stories and other media materials
- Enhanced understanding of gender statistics amongst civil society and the general public
- Increased number of academic institutions that train students on gender statistics (beyond students of statistics)
