







About the course

This course introduces three sets of international recommendations, namely: the "International Recommendations on Refugee Statistics" (IRRS), the "International Recommendations on IDP Statistics" (IRIS) and the "International Recommendations on Statelessness Statistics" (IROSS). The course is spread over six substantive modules and provides details on the statistical framework for compiling refugee, IDP and stateless persons statistics. It introduces concepts, definitions, classifications and methodologies relevant in collecting, compiling, analyzing and disseminating data and indicators on refugees, IDPs and stateless persons, including the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) indicators.


