#### International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- As per 15<sup>th</sup> ICLS guidelines "informal sector is a group of production units which form part of household sector as household enterprises or unincorporated enterprises owned by households."
- As per 17<sup>th</sup> ICLS framework "informal employment is identified by jobs classified by status of employment of the workers and type of production units in which they were employed."

## Operationalizing International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- Central Statistics Office (CSO)
  - The terms used in the Indian NAS are 'organised' and 'unorganised' sectors (unionized and non-unionised in the international literature).
  - Recently, during base year revision for National Accounts, as recommended by SNA 2008, Unincorporated enterprises belonging to households, which have complete sets of accounts have been treated as quasi corporations. (proprietorship and partnership enterprises, maintaining accounts).

## Operationalizing International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- Central Statistics Office (CSO)
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Economic Census (conducted in 2013-14)
    - Complete count of all establishments/units engaged in various agricultural and non-agricultural activities located within the geographical boundaries of India.
    - An establishment is a unit or an economic entity situated in a single location in which predominantly one kind of economic activity is carried out such that at least a part of the goods and/or services produced by the unit is sold.
    - Collected various useful characteristics for classifying an enterprise as an informal sector enterprise.

### Operationalizing International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- National Sample Survey Office (NSSO)
  - 68<sup>th</sup> Round survey (July 11 June 12):
    - Information on enterprise type was collected and enterprise type proprietary and partnership are classified as informal sector enterprises.
    - Information on condition of employment for certain industry groups was collected to identify informal employment.
    - Information on employment status, type of job contract, availability of paid leave, social security benefits etc. was collected.
    - The estimates of workers by characteristics of enterprises and conditions of employment together present a picture of informal employment in the country.

### Operationalizing International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- National Sample Survey Office (NSSO)
  - 73<sup>rd</sup> Round (July 15 to June 16)
    - Information on Unincorporated Non-agricultural Enterprises will be collected.
    - Information on employment particulars (formal, informal workers), compensations etc. will be collected.
    - Results will help CSO in generation of National Accounts and prepare Supply-Use Table.

## Operationalizing International Statistical Definition of Informal Sector

- Labour Bureau
  - Annual Employment Unemployment Survey (EUS)
    - In the 4<sup>th</sup> EUS, a beginning has been made to assess the size, structure and characteristics of the informal sector in the labour market.
    - Informal sector enterprises include only Proprietary and Partnership enterprises within AGEGC and nonagricultural sectors.
    - Information on characteristics of enterprises and conditions of informal employment was collected.
